Parliamentary/New Members

Traffic Safety Update

- Matt Traub called 311 to learn about new parking signs out in the front of the portables. 311 had not called back by the meeting date. Should hear back 9/14
- Luanne discussed that the signs were for special education buses—not the case anymore
- Signs should be consistent on the street.
- School Zone flashing signs are not on the correct schedule. 2:00 is when the lights flash. Lights end before 3:00. Should flash until 3:15. Mrs. Cobb is putting in a work order.

Facilities and Advisories Committee

- Current Bond - getting AC fixed. Assessments are being conducted around the building.
- Gym windows- leaks
- Ada regulations - bathroom doors are being changed
- Chairlift/stage extension
- Potholes in café/driveway area.
- This year AISD Bonds Committee- plan for the 2017 election—what facilities we need to go into the next bond?
- **CAC wants to request someone from the bond committee to attend a meeting to discuss how much can be spent/what projects can be done.**

- L. Wallace requests that an AISD Bond Representative

Campus Improvement Plan

- Due Friday 9/16
- Last year we received new improvement plan
- Amber will send improvement plan tomorrow 9/14. The CAC will have a month before the improvement plan needs to be approved.
- Campus Improvement plan- required document that looks at nonviolence, attendance etc. - document that shows how we develop within special populations etc. 40 items can be reported.

Principal Report- STAAR Data

- Results were received late in July—3-5th only
- Index 1- Passing- Brentwood 81% State - 60%
- Index 2-Student Progress- Brentwood 51% State 32%
- Closing performance Gaps (SES)- Brentwood 35 pts State 28 pts
- Post-Secondary Readiness- Advanced Levels- Brentwood 54% State 12%
- Brentwood increased! Amber Laroche emphasized that we are not only assessed by STAAR- We shared celebrations—Campus Culture and CLI
- 650 Students are at Brentwood today.
- Brentwood will receive a storage container located by Brentwood Pool and the building.
 - The unit will be used to store P.E. equipment.
 - The current P.E. office will be changed into a lounge.
- 1 new Kindergarten teacher will begin working next week. 9/19

- The district reports that there is plenty of room for more portables on track area.
- **Murals on the storage container and portables was proposed by _____.**
 - Fundraising by PTA and CAC--- Committee will vote in the future/look into plans.
- Books- 300 to be delivered by scholastic to teachers for Literacy Initiative—-independent reading- conferencing for comprehension.
 - K. Wiley discussed meeting with PTA and CAC—What will teachers do with new books/how will they store them?
 - New arrival date with books—pushed back

PTA Report

- PTA has been discussing fence signs like Lamar and McCallum to promote sponsors to the school. Hoping to move forward with signs. Sponsors would donate money and get their name on the sign. These signs would be tried for a year. The signs would be uniform.
 - The signs 2 x 4 would be \$1,000
- 215- PTA Members. T-shirts were delivered to classroom teachers.
- T-shirt sales are open until Back to School Night—9/21-9/22. Final orders will be placed then.
- Keep It Simple fundraiser has begun—till Oct 15th for \$15,000. Made beyond that last year.
- If we make half our goal (\$8,000) by Sept. 30th students will get pj party—Full goal—something fun at the carnival.
- Diaz Market donated \$700 to the PTA.
- First PTA meeting this Thursday 9/15 about culture fusion.

- Parent wanted to know if Brentwood sprays for mosquitos—the district uses the safest chemical they can.
