- * Option 1 is the model most similar to the 2015 AISD G&G 50/50 Model. Those campuses that elect to continue with the G&G Model would implement all G&G components in place of ELD, including classroom LOD, bilingual centers, etc.. Option 1 uses ELD in place of those G&G components.
- ** Options 1, 2 & 3 are recommended for both One Way and Two Way DL, as they all provide Simultaneous Literacy.
- *** All content areas require “Teaching for Transfer” in the language opposite to language of instruction (LOI).

Note: Options 2 & 3 instruction in the content areas in grades 2-5 follow a two-week English and two-week Spanish instructional cycle (i.e., Week 1-2 Spanish, Week 2-3 English)
